## OUR STUDENTS

All students are either expelled, truant, or referred by probation. Although we have capacity for 20 students, our numbers usually average 9 - 15 students at a time.



## OUR STAFF

Our dedicated and highly trained staff includes 2 classroom teachers, a transitional assistant, a counselor, a principal, and an administrative assistant. All work together with the unified goal of providing a wholesome and healthy learning environment for students to work toward high school graduation and

continued educational success. Students are provided with a highly structured environment and constant supervision as they strive to meet their individual educational goals.



## OUR PROGRAM

Earle Jamieson Educational Options operates on a traditional school calendar which includes 180 student instructional days. In addition to a highly structured and caring learning environment, students are provided support in individual learning plans, vocational counseling, conflict management, and making healthy lifestyle choices. Our dedicated staff offers mentorship and provides direct and constant supervision throughout the day.
