



American Red Cross Lifeguard Training



The Lifeguard Training class is designed for new lifeguards or for a person who's lifeguard certification has expired. Lifeguards who need to re-certify are welcome to join us, but will have to participate in the full schedule. Each participant who successfully completes all class requirements will receive a Lifeguarding/First Aid/ CPR/AED certification which is valid for 2 years.

Details

- When: Monday - Friday; March 21-25, 2016 (new lifeguards)
Friday - Saturday, March 25 & 26, 2016 (recertification)
- Time: 9:00am - 4:00pm each day
- Where: Memorial Park in Grass Valley
(meet at the Club House; 415 Central Ave.)
- Fee: \$185 per person; includes books & equipment (Code: LGT116)
\$75 per person; for re-certifications (Code: LGT216)

Pre-requisite Requirements:

1. Must be at least 15 years old. **Proof of age must be provided with registration** (original birth certificate, driver's license, etc).
2. Water Skills Test. The test will take place the first day of class. To pass the water skills test, participants must pass the 3 following objectives:
 - A. Swim 300 yards continuously demonstrating breath control and rhythmic breathing. Candidates may swim using the front crawl, breaststroke or a combination of both but swimming on the back or side is not allowed. Swim goggles may be used.
 - B. Tread water for 2 minutes using only the legs. Candidates must place their hands under the armpits.
 - C. Complete a timed event within 1 minute, 40 seconds. Starting in the water, swim 20 yards. The face may be in or out of the water. (Swim goggles are not allowed.) Surface dive to a depth of 6 ft, swim 10-15 ft along the bottom to retrieve a 10-pound brick. Return to the surface and swim on the back to the starting point with both hands holding the object at the surface and the face remaining at or near the surface or able to get a breath.
Candidates can not swim the distance underwater.

Participants should bring a swimsuit, towel, lunch and snacks with them each day.

I state that said minor is physically able to participate in said activity. I hereby agree to indemnify and hold the persons and entities mentioned above free and harmless from any loss, liability, damage, cost, or expense which they may incur as a result of the death or any injury or property damage that said minor may sustain while participating in said activity. I agree that in the event that said minor requires medical treatment while under the supervision of City of Nevada City and Northern Sierra Aquatics personnel in connection with described activity, such supervisor may authorize treatment.
