RE: Presentation and Review of Hirschman Trail Signage

Ms. Sheri Brown-Dion is the contractor selected for creation of the Hirschman Trail Signage. Her and Dawn Zydonis, Parks and Recreation Supervisor, will be presenting the proposed signage for the trail to the Planning Commission.

## **BACKGROUND**

The Planning Commission, in 2007, approved the Hirschman's Pond Trail and the project description is listed below:

*The City of Nevada City, as lead agency, and the Nevada County Land Trust are preparing an application for a Recreation Trail Program grant (RTP) that would fund the construction of a 2.0-mile, non-motorized, recreational trail through the City's Hirschman's Pond and Indian Trails Subdivision properties. The trail will traverse 83 acres, beginning at Cement Hill Road, just west of the Nevada County Government Center. The first one-half mile of the trail will be built to accessible standards, from the trailhead to the edge of Hirschman's Pond. The trail will then extend 1.5 miles through Parcel A, one of four Open Space Parcels which were dedicated to and accepted by the City with the recordation of the Indian Trails Subdivision, and through two privately-owned parcels on recorded trail easements*

## **COMMISSION ACTION**

While the City does not have any sign standards for trails specifically, the Commission will be reviewing and providing input on the design on the proposed signage.
