Street Sweeping in Nevada City

Street sweeping is used for the purpose of maintaining storm water collections in Nevada City. The City does not have a schedule for the street sweeper. The streets are swept on an as-needed basis with priority being given to the

streets that have storm drains on them and the ones that cause flooding to homes and businesses if clogged. We do not sweep streets for the aesthetics but to maintain our storm water collection system.

Please do not blow/sweep/rake/etc. any of your property's yard debris into the street or sidewalks. You can order a yard waste container from Waste Management at 530-274-3090.

Safe Medication Disposal Program

Nevada City Police Department recently received a Safe Medication Disposal Cabinet that is located in the Police Dept. offices and available to residents during business hours (Mon-Fri; 8a-noon and 1-5p). NCPD received this security cabinet through a

grant sponsored by The Rite Aid Foundation as part of their KidCents Safe Medication Disposal Program. The goal of this program is protecting kids and teens in our community by providing a safe place for individuals to safely dispose of expired or unwanted

medications (pill form—no liquids). If you have unwanted or expired prescription or OTC medications at home please come by and safely dispose of them. For more information feel free to contact the Police Department at 265-4700.
