



Play-Well 2020 Summer Program

Safety Modifications updated May 10th, 2020.

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, Play-Well recognizes that our in-person summer camps will need to be run with modifications. The following are precautions we are prepared to implement but will be following individual guidelines of the our partner locations which host our programs and changes to the recommendations of the local governments and CDC guidelines. The below will continue to change as different phases for reopening happen in different parts of the country.

Play-Well Instructors will:

- Wear face masks.
- Wash hands/sanitize often, and encourage students to do so.
- Wipe down high contact surfaces.
- Use painter's tape or large tables to indicate where to sit in order to spread kids out and encourage social distancing.
- Sort, separate and label separate groups of materials for each child to use exclusively throughout the program.
- Clean LEGO® Materials for the following week
- Talk about safety measures with students and encourage proper social distancing and hand washing techniques.

Play-Well Management will:

- Adjust the max number of kids enrolled in each program.
- Safety training for staff
- Provide PPE
- Cancel class if our staff is feeling ill

Families can help by doing the following:

- Take students to the bathroom before class (this will help minimize the usage during class)
- Wash hands before or after class
- Don't send your child to class if they have any symptoms of illness or are exposed to someone who is experiencing symptoms
- Talk to your child about how class will be different and what socially distant means (instructor will be wearing a mask, they will have an assigned area to sit, they need to keep a safe distance from other children, they will need to wash hands often).
- Be flexible and patient with our staff. This is not "business as usual." We are working hard to adapt and accommodate all of the guidelines and requirements in order to offer programming to your students.
